2022 HAWAI'I AGRICULTURE CONFERENCE ANNOUNCES KEYNOTE SPEAKER

EARLY BIRD REGISTRATION DEADLINE EXTENDED UNTIL AUG. 5

HONOLULU, HI - The 2022 Hawai'i Agriculture Conference, AG2022, announces a prominent figure in Hawai'i's food production industry as its keynote speaker. **Chad Buck**, founder and owner of local companies such as Hawai'i Foodservice Alliance and HFA Logistics, will headline the all-agriculture conference to happen in nearly three years. Hosted by the Agricultural Leadership Foundation of Hawai'i (ALFH) will take place in-person on September 27 & 28, 2022 at the Hawai'i Convention Center. Early bird registration has been extended until August 5 for the discounted price of \$300.

In alignment with this year's conference theme, "Collaborative Leaders as Ag-ents of Change," Buck's companies are focused on building and equipping first generation leaders, and driving Hawai'i toward a more sustainable and food secure future. Conference programming will reflect the need for Hawai'i's agriculture sector and its affiliated industries to provide collaborative leadership to proactively address a changing environment..

"Speaking at this year's Hawai'i Agriculture Conference could not come at a more opportune time," says Chad Buck. "There is much to share since the covid lockdown in 2020 about what we experienced as food providers and distributors. The biggest takeaway being that covid was a wake up call for our state in that we need to do a necessary shift and focus on growing our own food and feeding our own people."









The conference will open with *The State of Agriculture in Hawai'i Today* presentation, which will provide context that will enhance participation throughout the conference. Also on Day 1, attendees will hear Chad's thought-provoking keynote titled *Juggernauts to Expanding Hawai'i Agriculture*. Day 2 of the conference will open with a look at *The Future* presented by Future Farmers of America (FFA) students. Throughout the conference, attendees may choose among 24 breakout sessions within three conference tracks - *Community Collaboration, A Vibrant Workforce*, and *Business of Agriculture*.

AG2022 registration includes access to two full days of plenary sessions, concurrent sessions, the exhibit hall, and all meal functions. Student registration is priced at \$150 and applies to Middle School, High School, and College (Undergraduate and Graduate) students.
